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Short description of the tool	Ignite is an innovative and fast-paced style used to deliver a concise presentation. During an Ignite Talk, presenters discuss their research using 20 image-centric slides which automatically advance every 15 seconds. The result is a fun and engaging five-minute presentation.
Strong points	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Presentations are fast, very engaging, and focused on one specific topic or subject matter emphasizing the Key Message that is being delivered. • Having limited time might pressure the students but it allows to include only topic's most important idea. Speakers are forced to be far more concise and thoughtful than they would be in any other format. • It lets the students to focus on what will meet their audience's needs and expectation.
Weak points	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If there's a need to use multimedia, Ignite won't work very well as video doesn't fit well into the format. • Since the presentation runs automatically, the speaker doesn't have time for extensive audience interaction during the presentation. However, since the presentation is short, the time after the speech works well for Q&A or discussion.
