

Scenario of creative digital innovation in career counselling/orientation: Digital trail during work placement

Title: Digital trail during work placement

Method of delivery: Blended

Phase of career counselling/orientation: Which type of education/ work suits me? Where can I do that?

Duration: 1 day - 1 week (or longer; depending on the duration of the internship)

Target group: Young people (young adults) who do an internship in a company within vocational orientation projects.

Size of target group: 1-1 situation, evaluation in group possible

Scenario: As part of the vocational orientation, young people go through several company internships. Usually, they write a report to document the internship. This report is also used for an evaluation discussion with the supervisor (educator). In the SimplyDigi process, we use the tool "Actionbound" for documentation. The supervisor creates a bound in advance with tasks for the week of the internship.

Learning setting(s) for this scenario:

- 1. Classical setting: at school
- 2. Setting in a course or measure outside school in an organisation
- 3. Setting in a company
- 4. Individual (or in small groups) shorter and longer guidance phases by educational and vocational counsellors in an organisation
- 5. Transnational "European" learning environments

Used Tool: Actionbound

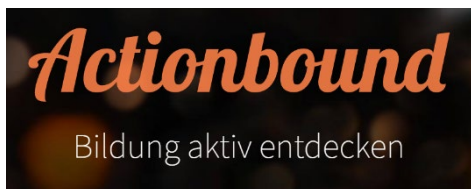
TIPP:

This scenario is also working in the same way for schools, etc

In small tasks, the students can compile information about the internship and thus document what and where and with which people they did their internship. And the best thing is: it works not only in words but also in pictures and sound.

Step 1: Create Bound

After registering at <https://actionbound.com/>, you can start right away and create a bound. Then, you decide whether the students play the bound alone or as a group. In our example, it is a single bound.

Step 2: Create questions and tasks

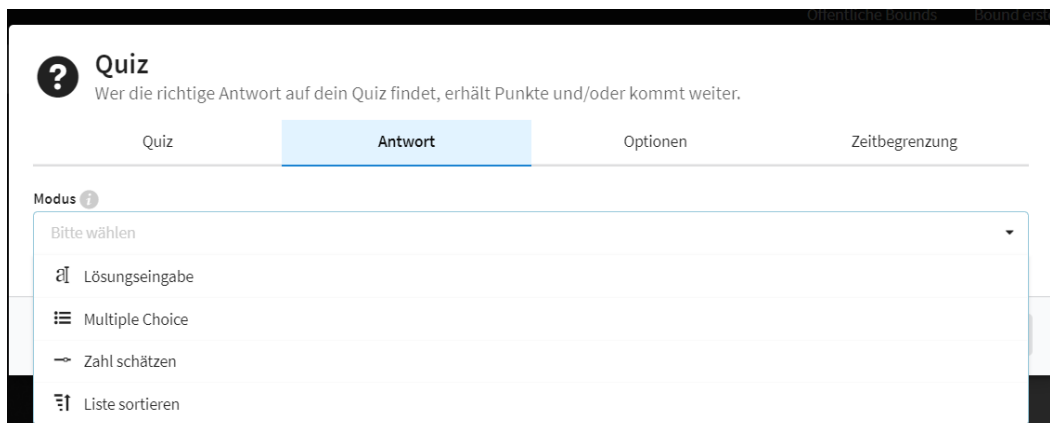

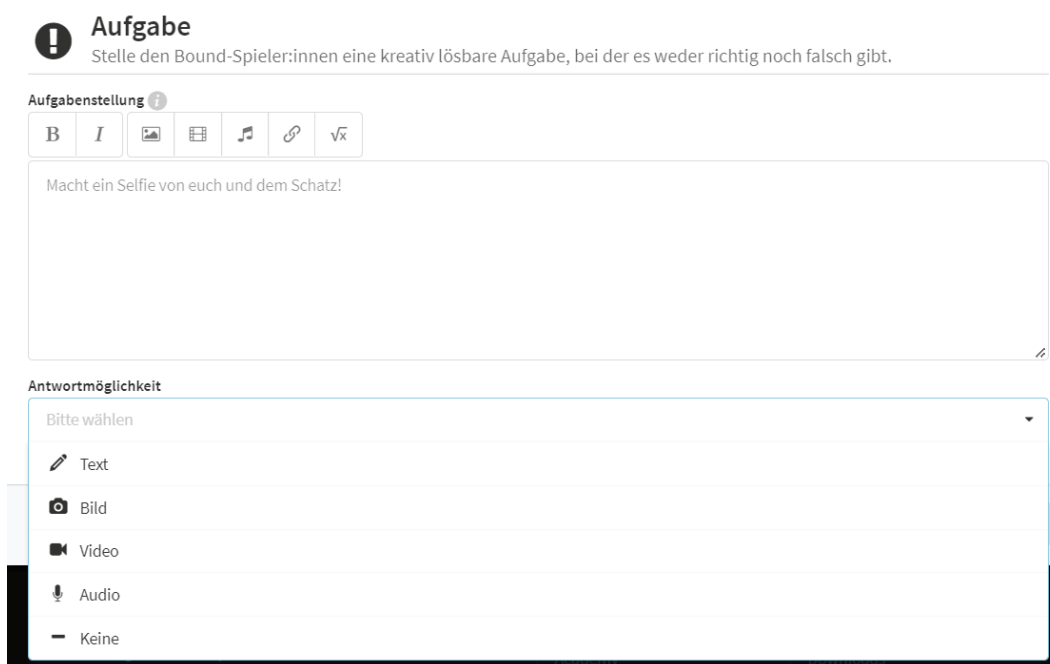
In this bound, you get various tasks and questions to document your work placement.

First of all, helpful information can always be inserted at the beginning and between.

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You can create one or more questions as a quiz (e.g. exciting facts about the occupational field). Different questions are possible: open text entry, multiple-choice, estimating or sorting numbers.

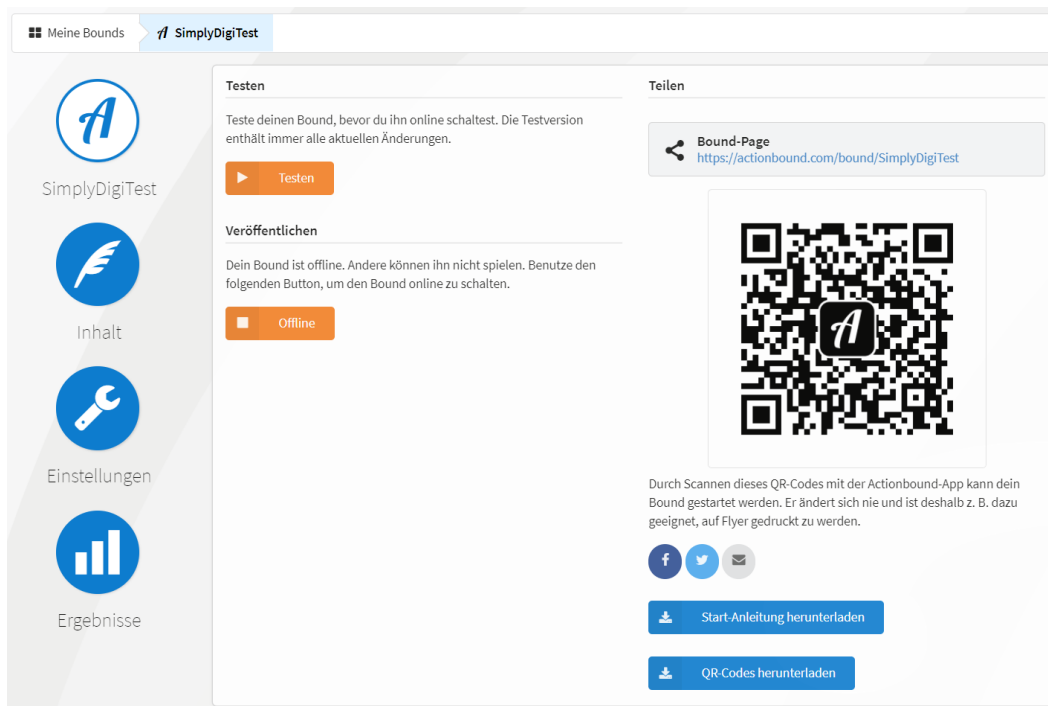


The task function is best suited for the actual documentation of the internship. The answer or the execution of the task can be done in text, picture, video or audio. So not only questions about the company (location, branch, size etc.) can be answered, but also, for example

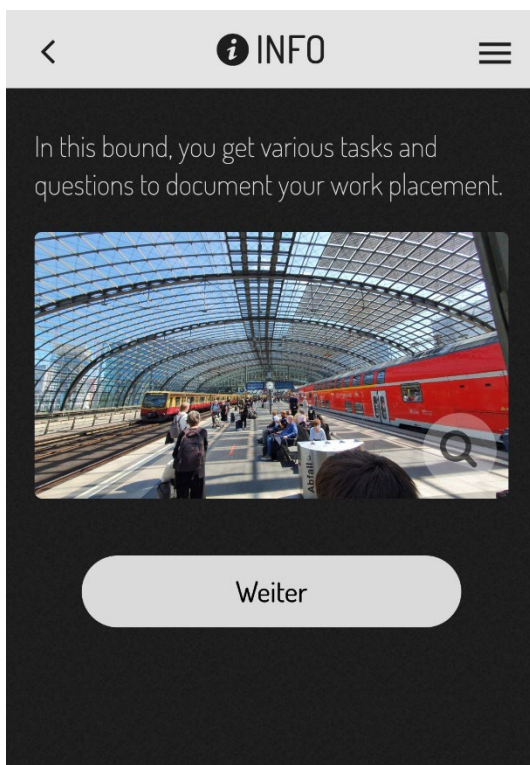
- short interviews with trainees or trainers are conducted (video or audio),
- the internship position can be presented with photos or videos,
- Pictures of typical working materials can be taken or
- usual environmental noises at the internship site (e.g. workshop) can be recorded as an audio file.

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Step 3: Put Bound online and play



When the Bound is ready, put it online. For your students to play the Bound, they must first install the free app on their smartphones (IOS or Android).



Next, the pupils receive a QR code and solve the various tasks in the Actionbound app.

The app guides them from task to task. The students can solve everything one after the other and document it accordingly or pause their bound in between and continue it later.

In the end, they complete the compound and upload the results.


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Step 4: Collect, sift and evaluate results

After the internship, an evaluation with the supervisor is essential. An evaluation in a group is also possible. It makes sense because in this way the other young people get to know activities and companies in which they have not yet tried their hand.

During career orientation, young people usually go through several internships. Since sensory perceptions and feelings are documented, and facts and audio-visual media are used, it becomes easier for the young person to remember. And then decide about their future career during the decision-making phase.
