

Scenario of creative digital innovation in career counselling/orientation: WHY AN INTERNSHIP ABROAD?

Title: WHY AN INTERNSHIP ABROAD?

Method of delivery: virtual, face to face

Phase of career counselling/orientation: Does that match my goals? Am I willing to decide?

Duration: 20 min.

Target group: Apprentices or your adults going for an internship abroad

Size of the target group: any

Scenario: Usually, apprentices or young adults who are thinking about doing an apprenticeship abroad do not consider the positive side effects of such an experience.

Career counsellors, sending organisations and intermediary organisations involved in the design and implementation of international traineeships are very clear about the beneficial effects and skills that participants acquire, which go far beyond technical skills, which are very important, but embrace all the soft skills that the labour market and the practice of active citizenship require.

Explaining before departure to apprentices and young people who have applied for an international apprenticeship what soft skills they will be able to acquire through this experience. This awareness is very important because only then will they be able to consciously put what they have learnt into practice.

However, one must always bear in mind that, especially when dealing with young people, their attention threshold is very low and that it is therefore very important to use innovative and dynamic modes of communication.
